

Parent/Carer Information

The ESSET Outreach Service works in partnership with schools to enhance support for children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). Our goal is to help schools develop inclusive practices and build the skills and confidence needed to meet a wide range of needs effectively.

We are a team of four Quadrant Outreach Leads, all of whom come from specialist school settings and have leadership experience.

All support provided by the ESSET Outreach Service is tailored to the individual. This means any advice, strategies, or recommendations are specifically designed for the child, their classroom and the wider school environment.

Schools can request our support for whole-school initiatives, specific groups, or individual pupils. For individual support, schools will ask for your permission. Children do not need to have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) to access our services.

Our support may include:

- Visiting the school to observe and assess the child's needs
- Providing tailored recommendations and strategies
- Coaching school staff and modelling interventions
- Delivering staff coaching
- Reviewing plans, targets, and suggesting ways to improve inclusive teaching
- Liaising with other professionals involved in the child's education, if necessary

Please note: we are not a pathway to specialist provision and cannot give guidance on school placements or EHCP applications.

Our commitment is to promote inclusion, build confidence within schools, and support positive outcomes for every child and young person with SEND.
